6. Public Hearings

Case #20-04-REZ: Evergreen Community Church Trustees (District #2: Powhatan Station/Graceland) requests the rezoning of Tax Map Parcel #40-39 from Commerce Center (CC) to Agricultural-10 (A-10) and amendment of the zoning district map of approximately 4.817 acres of land located on the south side of U.S. Route 60 (Anderson Highway) approximately 200 feet east of State Route 628 (Lower Hill Road) (3001 Anderson Highway). The applicant proposes construction of a place of worship. The 2019 Long-Range Comprehensive Plan designates the subject property as Rural Residential and Rural Enterprise Zone on the Countywide Future Land Use Plan with recommended residential densities of one unit per five acres.

In accordance with Sec. 68-175(e)(5)(d) of the Powhatan County Subdivision Ordinance, the applicant is also requesting a modification to local intersection spacing requirements set forth in Table 68-175(e)(5)(d), allowing a new commercial entrance to be constructed along U.S. Route 60 (Anderson Highway) approximately 450 feet east of its intersection with State Route 628 (Lower Hill Road) and approximately 215 feet west of the existing commercial entrance serving 2927 Anderson Highway.

Mr. Pompei provided an overview of the request.

Dean Hawkins, a representative for the applicant, introduced himself to members of the Planning Commission and signaled his availability to answer any question they may have.

Members of the Planning Commission and the applicant discussed the following:

- Parking Lot Visibility: The applicant stated that they will adhere to the corridor buffer standards in the Powhatan County Zoning Ordinance and described the sloping topography of the property, which will help to shield the parking lot from view.
- Proposed Turn Lane and Traffic Flow: The applicant provided an overview of the proposed transportation improvements and stated that they will be responsible for covering the cost of the proposed turn lane from U.S. Route 60 (Anderson Highway).
- Stormwater Management Plan: The applicant gave an overview of proposed on-site stormwater management plans.

Dr. Brown opened the public hearing.

Ms. Kingery made a motion to accept the new proffered condition brought forward by the applicant, which addresses landscaping/buffering along U.S. Route 60 (Anderson Highway).

8. Workshop

a. Presentation by the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) about Transportation Planning

Representatives from VDOT, Rebecca Worley and Adam Wilkerson, presented information about the services VDOT provides to Powhatan County, including plan review, traffic studies, assessing level-of-service rating for VDOT maintained roads, and access management.

Representatives for VDOT also provided updates on some VDOT programs, including the arterial preservation program, innovative intersections, and various transportation funding programs.

b. Discussion: 2020/2021 Comprehensive Plan Update (Future Land Use Plan)

Mr. Pompei provided the Planning Commission with an overview of updates made to the draft Future Land Use Plan since the previous Planning Commission workshop.

Members of the Planning Commission went through the draft text and discusses the changes that have been proposed. Discussion included:

- Consideration of the Chesterfield County Future Land Use Map when determining land use designations along the Powhatan County line; and
- Pros and cons of incorporating commercial nodes in the Route 60 Corridor East Growth Area.
